Cost of living support for tenants

Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Councils are supporting tenants impacted by the cost of living crisis with help to pay their rent and service charges.

The Councils' Household Support Fund, is discretionary financial support for tenants who are struggling with their housing costs.

In addition to rent and service charges, the fund can also assist with the reduction of rent arrears where appropriate.

To be eligible for support households must

- Live in the district of either Mid Suffolk or Babergh
- Be having difficulty affording their rent or service charges
- Have already attempted to resolve their situation through traditional means such as benefit applications, or a Discretionary Housing Payment.

All applications are assessed on a case by case basis, with households also being directed to other support for their issues.
